The text, ServSafe Essentials, is part of the Foundation's food safety program. After completing the classroom work, participants take a national certification exam developed by the Educational Foundation.

**The ServSafe Course is for:**

- Managers of food service operations for hotels, restaurants, schools, clubs and institutions.
- Food and Beverage Managers
- Catering Managers
- Chefs
- Dietary Managers

**Cleanliness and Safe Food Matter:**

- The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) estimate that foodborne diseases cause 76 million illnesses and 5,000 deaths annually.
- The public is concerned about cleanliness and safe food.
- Food establishments have been closed for critical health code violations, such as pest infestation, unsanitary work environment, improper storage and handling of food, poor hygiene practices and foodborne disease outbreak.
