


## Booker T. Washington National Monument Trail Map #8



### General Information:

Booker T. Washington National Monument commemorates the birthplace of America's most prominent African American educator and orator of the late nineteenth and early twentieth centuries. The property evokes an 1850's middle class tobacco farm, representative of Booker T. Washington's enslaved childhood.

The site boasts two walking trails: Plantation Trail is a short loop through the historic area, while Jack-O-Lantern Branch Heritage Trail is a 1.5 mile walk that meanders through fields and forests. There is also a picnic area, farm area, and garden area on site. Trail guides are available at the Visitor Center.

### Directions to Trailhead:

- \* From Rocky Mount at second exit off US 220, take VA-40/Franklin St. toward lake for 1.1 miles, then turn left (at light) onto VA-122/Booker T. Washington Hwy, travel northeast for 12.6 miles, park will be on the right (look for wooden fences)
- \* From Hales Ford Bridge (SML) continue west on VA-122/Booker T. Washington Hwy for 4.2 miles, park access will be on the left
