



Uptown Rocky Mount Trail Map #4

General Information:

The Vernon Lee Lynch II Riverside Park otherwise known to the locals as just plain "Lynch Park" (http://www.franklincountyva.org/parks/park_lynch.htm) sits along the Pigg River and is the official takeout for the Pigg River Ramble River Festival. The park was donated by the Lynch Land Trust by the family of Dr. Vernon Lee Lynch II. This park provides an excellent access to the first official Franklin County Blueway from Waid Park to Lynch on the Pigg River.

The uptown Rocky Mount Trail connects three parks: Lynch, Mary Elizabeth, and Veteran's Memorial. Lynch Park and Veteran's Memorial Park are connected by a wooden walkway following the Pigg River. The connection between Veteran's Memorial Park and Mary Elizabeth Park is the sidewalk along South Main Street. It is a 1.2 Mile trek one way with a gentle slope up hill from the Pigg River towards Mary Elizabeth Park.



Directions to Trailhead:

- *From 220 North Bound, South of Rocky Mount, take the first Rocky Mount exit and drive 2.2 miles on South Main St, then make a left at the first stop light onto Scuffling Hill Rd, then the first left on to Old Fort Road. Lynch Park will be on the left.
- *From 220 South Bound, North of Rocky Mount, take the third Rocky Mount exit and make a right at the end of the ramp and then a right onto South Main St, then follow the directions above.
