


**Waid Park
Recreation Area
Trail Map #6**



General Information:

Waid Recreational Area is one of Franklin County's gems. This park includes hiking and handicap accessible walking trails, equestrian & mountain biking trails, ball fields, soccer fields, playgrounds, fishing on the Pigg River, two picnic shelters, picnic area platforms, bird watching areas, plus an original portion of the 18th century Carolina Road. Annual events such as the Pigg River Ramble and Kids' Fishing Derby are held here.

Directions to Trailhead:

- * From 220 South Bound, take the first Rocky Mount exit, go 2.6 miles, turn right onto 40W/Franklin St. at stoplight, follow 40W for 2.4 miles, turn right onto Six Mile Post Rd at stoplight, go 1.8 miles then turn left into Waid Park entrance
- * From 220 North Bound, take the first Rocky Mount exit, go 2.4 miles to stoplight, turn left onto Scuffling Hill Rd, go 3.8 miles (cross 40W and continue onto Six Mile Post Rd) then turn left into Waid Park entrance
