AT A REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, VIRGINIA, HELD AT THE FRANKLIN COUNTY GOVERNMENT CENTER ON TUESDAY, AUGUST 16, 2016

A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE FRANKLIN COUNTY 2025 COMPREHENSIVE PLAN BY UPDATING, ADOPTING, AND INCORPORATING INTO THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN THE 220-NORTH CORRIDOR PLAN, DATED AUGUST 16, 2016.

WHEREAS, on February 17, 2009, the Board of Supervisors adopted the 220-North Corridor Plan as part of the Franklin County 2025 Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has decided as part of the update of the 220-North Corridor Plan to adopt a Designated Growth Area (DGA) in accordance with Section 15.2-2223.1 of the Code of Virginia, as amended, from the southern town limits of Boones Mill to the northern town limits of Rocky Mount, to include the proposed Regional Enterprise Park, the newly adopted water and wastewater service area boundary, and the Regional Business and Mixed Use Commercial Future Land Use Category boundaries, and

WHEREAS, after due legal notice as required by Section 15.2-2204/2205 of the Code of Virginia, as amended, the Planning Commission did hold a public hearing on July 12, 2016, and the Board of Supervisors held a public hearing on the proposed 220-North Corridor Plan amendment on the August 16, 2016 at which time all parties in interest were given an opportunity to be heard, and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of Franklin County, Virginia, that the Board of Supervisors hereby adopts the 220-North Corridor Plan, the Designated Growth Area (DGA), and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Board of Supervisors hereby amends the Franklin County 2025 Comprehensive Plan by incorporating into the County's Comprehensive Plan the 220-North Corridor Plan, dated August 16, 2016, for public necessity, convenience, general welfare, or good zoning practice.
