## PUBLIC INPUT SOUGHT ON PRIORITIZING TRANSPORTATION PROJECTS

The Commonwealth Transportation Board (CTB) will hold nine public meetings across the commonwealth in November on prioritizing transportation projects. Wednesday, November 18, 2015 from 4:30pm-6:30pm, Holiday Inn Valleyview, Roanoke, VA would be the closest meeting to Franklin County.

The public is invited to get the latest information, ask questions and provide input on transportation projects. This year's meetings will consist of the following:

1. A **open house format** where attendees can review and provide feedback on the list of proposed local and regional projects localities submitted to be scored under a new prioritization process as legislated by House Bill 2.
2. A **town hall style format** will be provided where the public and transportation stakeholders can engage in discussion and ask questions about the projects. There will be no formal public comment during the meetings.

The meetings will highlight the 321 applications for projects submitted by 131 local and regional governments across the state. The applications request \$6.95 billion in funding under House Bill 2.

Following public meetings, the projects will be scored through the end of December. Once projects are scored and reviewed by the public, the CTB will then select which projects to fund and be included in the next Six-Year Improvement Program by June of 2016.
