House Bill Two (HB2) Update:

On September 15th the Board of Supervisors authorized staff to submit an application for safety improvements for the FY 2017 Six Year Improvement Program Cycle. The project area is the intersection of Route 122 (Booker T. Washington Highway) and Route 636 (Hardy Road), this intersection was identified as one of the 100 top fatal and serious injury crash intersections in VTrans 2040. The proposed scope of the project would be a north bound left turn lane on Route 122; expansion of the existing south right turn lane on Route 122, access management improvement by closing one of two entrances to existing commercial businesses along Route 122, right-of-way acquisition, utility relocation, shoulder improvements on both sides of Route 122 with two feet (2') paved shoulder and three feet (3') graded shoulder, and roadway construction. Application was submitted to VDOT on Wednesday, September 30, 2015. Recipients of the funding should be notified in June of 2016.
