



**PURPOSE:** Franklin County Public Safety is committed to the citizens of Franklin County and this guideline shall work to ensure a timely and professional response of Engine 15.

**I. POLICY:**

- A. Engine 15 shall be stationed at public safety station number 15 located at 13205 Booker T. Washington Highway.
- B. The engine should be primarily operated by the career staff assigned to this station supplemented by volunteer staff.
- C. The apparatus shall be checked off daily utilizing the career fire apparatus check sheet.
- D. The engine shall have a minimum of 2 trained personnel prior to responding to calls for service, unless approved by the on duty Operations Captain.
- E. Personnel responding on Engine 15 shall have the following certifications: Virginia Fire Fighter 1 or above, Virginia Hazardous Materials Awareness level or above, EVOC Class 1, 2 and 3.
- F. Personnel shall have knowledge of and comply with all FCDPS SOG's.
- G. Personnel shall be familiar with response operations, refueling operations, and daily inspection checklist.
- H. Personnel shall have the knowledge of station 15 concept of operations for responding to Fire/EMS calls.
- I. Personnel shall have the ability to flow water from the vehicle within 2 minutes of setting the parking brake.
- J. Personnel shall have the ability to inject foam into the appropriate attack line(s) at the proper percentage.
- K. Personnel shall have the ability to shut down pump operations on the vehicle.
- L. Personnel shall have the ability to fill the tank of the apparatus utilizing both a draft water source as well as a hydrant.

- M. Personnel shall have the ability to locate and correctly utilize all radios and portable equipment on the apparatus.
- N. Personnel shall have the ability to complete a NFIRS report to each incident. A complete NFIRS MUST be completed immediately after each call for service.
- O. Personnel shall properly complete and submit departmental training records for training received on the use/operation of the apparatus.
- P. Volunteers wishing to affiliate with station 15 shall complete a FCDPS volunteer for services applications and be vetted thorough the background checks as for any other volunteer station.
- Q. Apparatus shall be clean at all times.
- R. Engine 15 shall respond to all fire calls when requested if crew is available.
- S. Appropriate PPE shall be worn when operating at emergency scenes.
